



## Texas Lawyers for Texas Veterans Tarrant County Chapter *Needs your help!!!*

In 2010, the President of the State Bar of Texas launched the Texas Lawyers for Texas Veterans program to help our Texas Veterans who have served in the U. S. Armed Forces. “Our military servicemen and women have made great sacrifices in duty to their country,” said President Tottenham, a former Marine. “As lawyers, we have the opportunity to make a difference in the lives of a great many veterans—and in the families of those who did not return.”

TLTV-Tarrant County Chapter organizes legal clinics to coordinate with individual volunteer attorneys who provide consultation and legal counseling in family, consumer/finance, probate, estate planning, bankruptcy, landlord/tenant, criminal and other legal matters. The program does not provide assistance regarding veterans’ benefits. The clinics are held on the third Friday of every month, except the months of March and December. After the legal clinic, if the veteran meets certain income eligibility criteria (per the Texas Access to Justice Foundation Grant requirements), the case placement subcommittee makes all the arrangements to match the veteran with a pro bono attorney to represent him/her in their legal matter.

Because of attorneys like you, TLTV has served over 1,400 veterans since its inception in the Fall of 2010.

***You can volunteer in two ways – (1) attend the legal clinics on the third Friday afternoons from 2 to 5 p.m. to provide consultations to veterans; (2) volunteer to take a pro bono case in your area of practice.***
